In order to protect the participating members, all prospective participants must apply for and receive clearance through [InfraGard](#). If you are already an Infragard member, you are now enrolled in Tiger Trap 2010. If you have submitted your Infragard application, the process may take a few weeks, however you will be allowed to participate on a provisional basis pending your Infragard acceptance. Additionally, participants must conduct and attend pre-event team meetings and training sessions. Team meetings and training sessions will occur November 2009 - February 2010. ## Tiger Trap 2010 Schedule:

- First All Teams meeting: November 17<sup>th</sup> (Saturday) 10am-2pm at Blue Cross Blue Shield, 5525 Reitz Ave in Baton Rouge (off Bluebonnet near I-10)
  - Other team meetings TBD at the initial meeting
- Feb 19-March 16: White Team configures systems
- March 17-April 16: Red Team probing & recon.
- April 11-16: Blue Team reconnaissance & mapping
- April 16-22: Reimage devices and event prep (White Team)
- April 23-25: Capture the flag event onsite in Baton Rouge
- April 26-May 5: Auditors notes, analysis & scoring
- April 26-May 5: White Team training & presentation prep
- May 7: Event debrief, presentation & training session

Each team will be lead by two co-Captains. These members will be responsible for liaising with the White Team officials, ensuring team member participation, attendance & rule adherence and directing team efforts. Each team will be staffed with a team auditor(s). The auditors will chronicle team activities, successes, failures and serve as White Team official liaisons. AND, for the 2010 event participants may act as a mentor and bring one non-active observer.
